Greetings West Point Families,

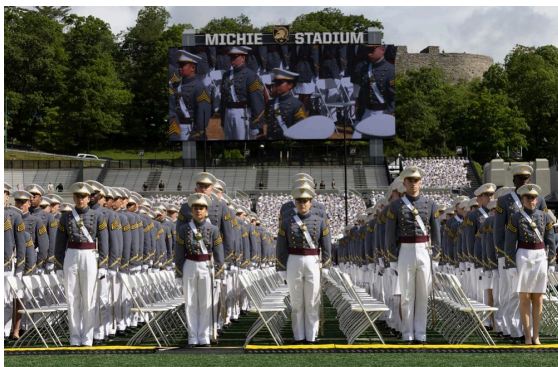

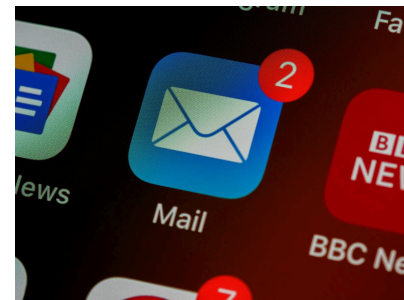
